	<p>On 01-01-2009 at approximately 0200hrs, patrol officers and street crimes officers responded to the Celebrations bar located at 2540 N Cherry Road in reference to assisting Crime Prevention Security Officers with a large crowd leaving the bar and a possible assault in the parking lot. While other Officers were assisting Crime Prevention, Sgt Stinson was sitting in his marked patrol vehicle monitoring the crowd when a black primer 1995 Nissan Maxima pulled up next to Sgt Stinson's vehicle. A strong odor of Marijuana could be detected from the vehicle. Sgt Stinson approached the vehicle and began to investigate the odor of Marijuana. The front passenger, Jeremy Stewart, was very nervous and kept reaching for his pockets. He was asked for consent to search his person for Marijuana and he gave consent. Sgt Stinson located a small baggy of marijuana in his right front pocket along with a burnt marijuana cigarette. These items were seized and later dropped into evidence. NCIC revealed that Jeremy Stewart had a prior conviction of possession of crack in 2006. He was issued warrant number K-327654 for possession of Marijuana 2nd. James Locke was also a passenger in the vehicle and he was asked to step out of the vehicle. When he did, Officers observed a small baggy containing marijuana in the seat where Locke was sitting. There was also a bottle of open vodka in the floor board where he was sitting. Locke was arrested and transported to the law center on ticket number 59766EO for Open Container and 59765EO for Possession of Marijuana 1st.. During the time that Sgt Stinson was dealing with the occupants in the Maxima. Street Crime Officers were assisting Crime Prevention security Officers with a disturbance across the parking lot.. Officers came in contact with Frederick Hart, who Crime Prevention Officers, had stopped for driving through the parking lot at a high rate of speed. Hart was verbally abusive to the Officers and was advised by Rock Hill Police Officers that he could potentially be arrested for disorderly conduct if he did not calm down and leave. Hart then began yelling, "F--k it, take me to jail." and he refused to</p>

calm down and leave. He was subsequently arrested for Disorderly Conduct (ticket number 54048EO). While Officers were dealing with Hart, Dyana Linen, who was a passenger in Harts vehicle, began to get irrate with officers. Linen was highly intoxicated using a lot of profanity toward officers. She was advised to calm down and stay in the vehicle several times. She dropped her cell phone on the ground at which time, Officer Stokes reached to pick it up and Linen swung at the Officer striking him in the back of the head but, not causing any injury. She was then arrested for disorderly conduct. Yukota Simpson was also in this vehicle and was being verbally abusive to Officers. He was asked to leave the premises several times by different Street Crime Officers. Simpson was refusing to leave at first stating, "I'm Ko Simpson with the Buffalo Bills. I am worth Millions"! Officers asked him several more times to leave at which time he continued to state "I'm Ko Simpson and I am worth Millions"! Simpson finally started to exit the parking lot. Officers were trying to secure the other subjects who were under arrest in patrol vehicles and also trying to secure Linen who was trying to kick out the window of patrol vehicle 135. During this time, Yukota Simpson had returned and walked up behind Officers who were already in a large crowd and began yelling and screaming trying to get to his friend, James Hart. This created more of a Officer Safety issue and Simpson was then arrested for Hindering Police (ticket number 24855EU). All subjects were transported to the law center without further incident. Hart's vehicle was towed by Bo Bo's wrecker from the scene.
